

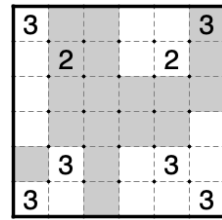

DOUBLE CHOCO

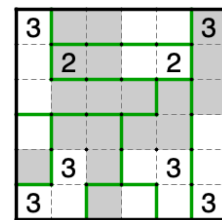
The Rules

- Divide the grid into blocks by drawing solid lines over the grid lines.
- A block must contain a pair of areas of white cells and grey cells having the same form (size and shape).
- One area may be a rotated or mirrored image of the other.
- A number indicates the number of cells of that colour in the block (half the total number for the block).
- A block can contain any number of cells with numbers.

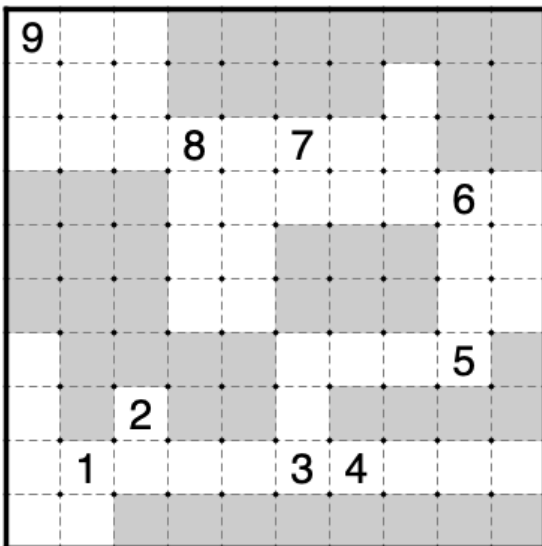

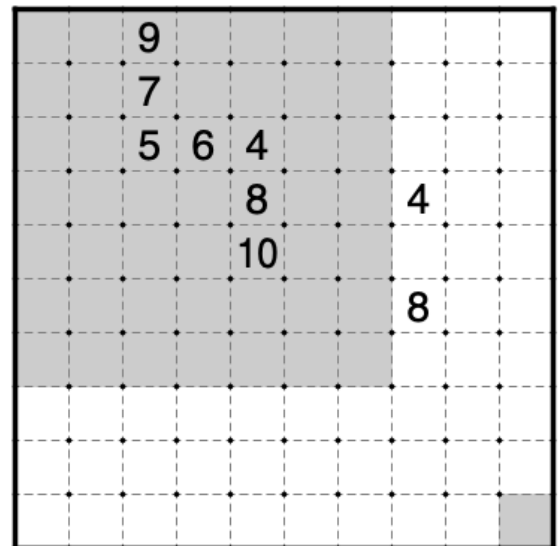
